NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Article 18-A of the New York State General Municipal Law, will be held by the Oneida County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") on the 28th day of June 2018 at 9:00 a.m., local time, at 584 Phoenix Drive, City of Rome, Oneida County, New York in connection with the following matters:

Griffiss Local Development Corporation, on behalf of itself, its principals, or an entity to be formed on behalf of any of the foregoing (collectively, the "Company") has applied to the Agency to enter into a transaction in which the Agency will assist in renovations to a vacant two-story, 19,800± square foot building (the "Improvements"), situated on a 0.989± acre parcel of land located at 775 Daedalian Drive, Griffiss Business and Technology Park, City of Rome, Oneida County, New York, also known as Building 778 (the "Land") and acquisition and installation of equipment in the Improvements (the "Equipment"), to accommodate a new tenant, Alion Science and Technology Corporation (the "Sublessee") for the purpose of the Sublessee providing technology and operational support to the Department of Defense (the Land, the Improvements and the Equipment are referred to collectively as the "Facility" and the renovation and equipping of the Improvements is referred to as the "Project"). The Facility will be initially managed by the Company and operated by the Sublessee.

The Agency owns the Land and Improvements and leases them to the Company pursuant to a Lease Agreement, and the Company will sublease the Facility to the Sublessee. At the end of the lease term, the Agency will convey the Facility to the Company. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance to the Project in the form of exemptions from mortgage recording tax and abatement of real property taxes for a period of nineteen (19) years, during which time the Company will pay fixed PILOT Payments, which financial assistance represents a deviation from the Agency's Uniform Tax Exemption Policy.

A representative of the Agency will at the above-stated time and place hear and accept written comments from all persons with views in favor of or opposed to either the proposed financial assistance to the Company or the location or nature of the Facility. A copy of the Application for Financial Assistance filed by the Company with the Agency, including an analysis of the costs and benefits of the proposed Project, is available for public inspection at the offices of the Agency, 584 Phoenix Drive, Rome, New York.
